## De Colores!!

I am currently reading Matthew Kelly's latest book called "Four Signs of a Dynamic Catholic". For the book, Matthew Kelly did extensive interviewing from Catholics of all types to determine what makes someone an engaged Catholic or not. He came to the conclusion that 7% of Catholics are dynamic Catholics who are highly engaged. He also determined that there are 4 signs of those who are engaged (which might not surprise you as Cursillistas)...prayer, study, generosity and evangelization. Three of these signs are directly related to the tripod that we review weekly in our group reunions and at Ultreyas. Cursillo gives us these tools to continually grow and stay balanced in our faith. That is why we focus on those areas of our prayer life, study and how we are making a friend, being a friend and bringing our friends to Christ, to thereby grow stronger ourselves in our own faith.

One thing interesting in the section on prayer was that Matthew Kelly found that those who excelled had not only a routine but they had a routine within a routine. They made prayer a priority by not only setting aside a time and place every day for their prayer but they had a routine that they routinely went through. Whether it is a morning offering, reflecting on the Gospel of the day, praying the morning prayers out of the magnificat, lectio divina or a daily devotional it does not matter as much as it matters that it helps you in prayer.

One of the pitfalls that he mentions is people's first attempt at prayer maybe to just sit down and see what happens. Often nothing happens and they get frustrated and quit praying. Find out what works best for your routine in a routine. Don't forget about the false forms of piety (guy version – Holy Joe, Pharisaical Phil and Mechanical Mike) especially the Mechanical Mike when you are just going through the motions and not getting much out of it. With Lent just around the corner, do you need to focus more on prayer and what works best for you at this point in time? You may also want to make it a Lenten resolution to routinely keep your routine.
